

## Cataract Surgery Options

The lens packages below are for your review. You will have an evaluation with the surgeon to discuss which options for which you are a candidate. Ultimately, you will decide which option is best suited for you and your desired surgical outcomes.

### Premium Lifestyle Lens Package (PLP)\*

Multi-focal lenses allow for an extended range of vision. This package is designed to reduce your dependence on glasses for distance, intermediate and near vision. Glasses may be needed occasionally to obtain your best vision, especially at near. Astigmatism will be corrected with a toric multi-focal or corneal relaxing incision if necessary. Your surgeon will discuss whether you are a candidate for this option. This option is not billable to your insurance.

**Your out-of-pocket cost *in addition* to any copays or deductibles is: \$4100.00 per eye**

### Personalized Vision Package (PVP)\*

This package offers a way to correct distance vision for those patients who want to reduce their dependence on glasses for distance by correcting astigmatism with a limbal relaxing incision or a toric IOL. It is important to understand that glasses will be needed for intermediate and reading after your surgery. This package would also include options for patients seeking astigmatic mono-vision correction. Typically, your surgeon will only recommend astigmatic mono-vision surgery if you've had experience with mono-vision prior to your cataract procedure. Your surgeon will discuss whether you are a candidate for this option. This option is not billable to your insurance.

**Your out-of-pocket cost *in addition* to any copays or deductibles is: \$3100.00 per eye**

### Femtosecond Laser-Assisted Cataract Surgery

This option is for patients who want to take advantage of the newest femtosecond laser assisted cataract surgery. There will be corneal relaxing incisions to reduce astigmatism. Bi-focal or progressive glasses may be needed after surgery. Your surgeon will discuss whether you are a candidate for this option. This option is not billable to your insurance.

**Your out-of-pocket cost *in addition* to any copays or deductibles is: \$2200.00 per eye**

### Standard Lens

This package includes a standard lens that does not correct astigmatism, intermediate or near distances. Bi-focal or progressive glasses may be needed after surgery.

This option is billable to your medical insurance. Coverage depends on your plan.

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### Light Adjustable Lens (LAL)

Light Adjustable Lens (LAL) is the first and only FDA approved intraocular lens implant (IOL) that can be adjusted after surgery. It allows us to collaborate with you to achieve the optimized results and truly design your own visual outcomes. It offers a way to correct distance vision for patients wanting to reduce their dependence on glasses for distance. This package would also include options for patients seeking blended vision or mono vision correction. It allows the surgeon to fine-tune the patient's vision in a non-invasive manner. Your surgeon will discuss whether you are a candidate for this option. This option is not billable to your insurance.

**Your out-of-pocket costs *in addition* to any copays and deductible is: \$5100.00 per eye.**

\* Included with these packages: Femtosecond laser assisted cataract surgery, ORA, and LASIK/PRK touch-up as needed.
